**Hand Car Shed**

1. New window glass
2. Remove broken 1x8s
3. Install new 1x8
4. Cut excess foundation runners
5. Install trim on door
6. Dirt work around foundation
7. Paint foundation trim boards
8. Remove metal roof piece
9. Build steps
10. Build doors and hang
11. Repair old wood on top
12. Install wainscot
13. Install battens
14. Remove old nails

**Caboose**

1. Clean out the interior
2. Plywood holes
3. Re-build steps
4. Plexi-glass windows
5. Remove air conditioner
6. Remove exterior bad wood
7. List items needed for restoration

**Site**

1. Clean up trash piles
2. Move RR ties
3. Clean up RR rails

There may be other things that need doing. Bring your tools. Wes, Craig, Jim and Hardy have already done some work, bringing electricity to the shed and beginning work both inside and out.

On July 4 the Granby police will have Agate Street blocked off for the parade. They will be rerouting all traffic right by our site. We would like to be working on site as traffic goes by. Any of us who can be there will help to provide public awareness of our project. We will have some signs ready by then.

New in-kind donations have been received or committed from community members, as follows:

The Roofing Company – 4 ½ squares of shingles for the hand car shed roof and ice/water shield material for the roof.

Byron Miller Construction – lumber for the shed, valued at \$300.

Union Pacific Railroad – 16 ties, 2 rails, rail plates and spikes, all for the UP caboose.

The Trash Company – 1 ton of free disposal of trash, and half price thereafter, and a dumpster.

Ride the Rockies is coming through Granby on June 17 & 18. We have been awarded the project to provide bike security at the High School. We will earn \$350 for our work. Dave will be setting up a schedule of 4 hour shifts for the period when the riders will be there. Let him know of your availability.
